



“TEAPOT” Workshop at BMCA Clay Studio Coming Soon

For five Tuesdays from March 31 – April 28, resident potter AJ Reisman will offer a workshop on how to make teapots at the Black Mountain Center for the Arts Clay Studio. Under Reisman’s instruction, potters will explore the process of creating pottery’s most intricate form, using both wheel-thrown and hand-building methods. Potters with some previous experience will learn to form the body of the teapot, create a well-pouring spout, and construct a well-fitting lid and a comfortable handle.

AJ Reisman studied clay at Warren Wilson College and went on to instruct in various studios throughout western NC and in central Vermont. AJ prefers functional ware off the wheel, obstructing forms, using earth tones and textures to reflect the pottery’s origin within the earth. In addition to teaching workshops and classes, AJ also provides Paint-On-Pottery session at the studio.

Enrollment in the workshop will include clay, glazes, firing, instruction and open studio time. Classes will be from 6-8 pm. Cost is \$150. For more details visit www.blackmountainarts.org, or
