Contest Details & Procedures

- You may enter the Chalk the Walk contest in one of the following categories:
 - Elementary ages 5 - 11
 - Teen ages 12 - 18
 - Adult over 18
 - Family or Small Group (no more than 5 members please)
- Everyone who would like to participate in the Chalk the Walk contest **must register and pay by September 25 at 12:00 pm** to be guaranteed a spot. If there are additional spots available we will offer them first come, first served on Saturday morning.
- Each individual or group must pay \$5 to participate. Payment can be made in the main office at the Black Mountain Center for the Arts (225 West State Street). Payments must be made with cash or checks.
- On Friday, September 27th each individual or group who has been registered and has paid for the contest will be emailed the number and location of their spot for the contest. Directions for picking up your chalk will be provided in this email as well.
- We will do our best to honor requests to be placed next to or near another participant, but cannot guarantee this will happen.
- Participants will be given a bag of chalk to use for their artwork. Participants are limited to using the chalk provided. Please do not use other materials as they may stain the sidewalks.
- Participants must complete their artwork within the defined 3 foot x 3 foot space they are assigned.
- Participants will have from 9:00 am - 11:00 am to create their masterpiece.
- Judging will begin at 11:00 am.
- One entry from each category will be chosen as the winner. There will be a \$50 cash prize for the winner of each category.
- Winners will be announced on social media on Saturday, September 28th in the afternoon.
- Prize money may be picked up at the Black Mountain Center for the Arts during normal office hours (10:00 am - 5:00 pm, Monday - Friday) beginning Monday, September 30th. Prize money not picked up by 12.1.24 will revert back to BMCA.
